

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Who is the Designer of the clubs?**

Jesse Ortiz, best known as the chief designer of his family's Orlimar Golf Company until 2003. Ortiz has crafted designs used by over 1,000 tour professionals worldwide

- **Can we get custom shafts?**

All Bobby Jones clubs can be ordered with the custom shaft options. We stock nearly every imaginable shaft. Custom length options are also available.

- **What graphite design shaft options are there for The Players Series?**

The Players Series is available with the graphite design shaft in the following shaft flexes.

1. X-stiff for swing speeds of 98+
2. Stiff for swing speeds of 91-97
3. Regular for swing speeds of 82-90

- **What style/brand of grips is on the clubs?**

All clubs are available with leather, Golf Pride's Tour velvet or Winn's new V-17 in our proprietary design. The Winn is standard on The Players and Women's line.

- **What size are the club heads?**

The Players driver is 440cc and classically pear shaped.

- **Who is the manufacturer of the Clubs?**

Bobby Jones Golf Co. is the manufacturer of the Bobby Jones Golf Club line. The Asian Foundry that produces the heads, also manufacturers for Japan's most famous brands.

- **What playing characteristics do the clubs fit?**

Due to our exclusive Russian Beta-Ti faces on the Drivers, and the Carpenter maraging faces on the fairway woods, all of our clubs provide very low spin rates. Our drivers are consistently below 2800 rpm on launch monitors. This is due to several factors: Our Beta face is 44 HRC on the Rockwell scale versus a typical 36 HRC of our competitors. We also put more curvature (bulge & roll) on our faces ... 9" x 9" versus 12" x 12" which is common in the industry. The extra curvature increases ball compression and velocity of the face. The Players series is for average to high swing speeds and are available in a variety of lofts to best suit each golfer's needs

- **What other clubs on the market would these be compared to?**

Bobby Jones is the only company to feature this maraging crown technology. The only competitor that is close to comparison is Sonartec, but we believe our metals are more classically shaped and much easier to hit due to the lower center of gravity.

- **When will clubs be available for left-handers?**

At this time there are no plans to add left-handed clubs. Only right-handed clubs are available for all Bobby Jones club lines.

- **What does the JS6 or JS7 mean?**

JS6: 4 degree torque low to mid kick point, 63 grams, regular flex.

JS7: 3 1/2 degree torque, true mid kick point, 73 grams shift flex.
